Upcoming Changes

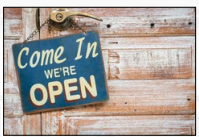

One way we are moving forward is through improvement of office efficiencies. More efficient office operations will position the Association to dedicate additional resources for networking and fellowship events, enhancing the local membership experience.
