Kyung-Ah Kim has given many recitals and concerts and has performed at festivals throughout the United States, Europe and Asia. She has collaborated with leading conductors such as John Williams, James Orent and Petr Atrichter, and she has performed with orchestras including the Boston Pops Orchestra, the Brno Philharmonic Orchestra, the NEC Philharmonic Orchestra, the Boston University Symphony Orchestra, the Seoul Philharmonic Orchestra, the Seoul Symphony Orchestra, the Busan Philharmonic Orchestra and the Kyunggi Philharmonic Orchestra, among others.

Kim received a Bachelor of Music, a Master of Music and a Graduate Diploma from the New England Conservatory, as well as a Doctor of Musical Arts degree from Boston University, studying with Russell Sherman, Wha Kyung Byun and Boaz Sharon. She is currently teaching at Seoul National University.
