Car Program – 5 Cars Provided

The second Saturday of every month we conduct a Food Pantry at Al Ansar Mosque. The box includes non-perishable food essentials meant to last a family for 1 month.

Prison Outreach – Monthly Jail Visits to Show Support

To support our asylum-seeking brothers and sisters who have been detained, our team regularly conducts jail visits. We provide detainees with books, financial deposits if ever needed and most importantly, emotional support. We encourage our community to involve themselves with these individuals, so that we can better provide them with their basic needs.
