Eid Gift Cards and Iftar Vouchers – Celebrating the Holy Month

We would like to extend our sincere gratitude to our community members who have donated during this blessed month of Ramadan. We were able to provide Eid gift cards and iftar vouchers to 300 families throughout the month.

Ramadan Food Drive – Community Support

We would like to thank OCIF for partnering with us for the fourth year in holding our annual food drive during the month of Ramadan. We were able to collect 600 pounds of food. We would like to our community that has supported and provided non-perishable goods to our program.

Ramadan Tabling – Building Community

This program is especially beneficial to asylum seeking families as they are not eligible for CalFresh. A sincere thank you to our generous community for helping us continue this program.

Tutoring Program – 6 to 8 Students Attended Weekly

Our Children's Refugee Tutoring Program is offered throughout the regular school year from 10:00AM to 11:30AM every Saturday at ISOC, or Garden Grove mosque. **During the summer we partnered with a local school to provide summer tutoring sessions.** We will resume the regular program in the Fall. Prison Outreach – Monthly Jail Visits to Show Support

To support our asylum-seeking brothers and sisters who have been detained, our team regularly conducts jail visits. We provide detainees with books, financial deposits if ever needed and most importantly, emotional support.
