What Your Child Learned Today

- Big Idea: God gives us wisdom. He tells us that we have a choice to make. We can choose the way of life and peace or the way of death and destruction.
- Memory Verse: "Out in the open wisdom calls out." Proverbs 1:20

SOMETHING ELSE TO DO

It's important to remember that everyone makes foolish choices sometimes. Even more important is that Jesus is always ready to forgive us. So, we don't have to live with the burden or shame of poor choices. Just as we need reminders of our need to be wise, we need reminders of that forgiveness. As a family, make a sign that simply says: Jesus Forgives Me. Decorate it with pictures of your family. This will serve as a beautiful reminder that we can live in God's wisdom and under Jesus's grace!
