The Immersion in Latin America course includes:

- 5 hours of individual Spanish language instruction with an emphasis on social work, healthcare, legal, and/or human rights and social justice (*depending on student interest*)
- Homestay with a local family (*room and board*)
- Lectures and trips focusing on the historic and contemporary social, economic, political, and cultural aspects of Guatemala

Cost: \$1000 per person

Cost **INCLUDES** homestay with a local family, 5 hours of language instruction per day, volunteer and community service opportunities, in-country transportation to and from Xela from Guatemala City, and honorariums for communities & organizations that we visit

Cost **DOES NOT INCLUDE** flight to and from Guatemala
