About the Program

Each year, the T. Howard Foundation welcomes a new class of diverse college students to its Internship Program.

A unique benefit for students participating in the Internship Program is being paired with mentors who share their career interests and goals.

Mentor Eligibility

Mentors must have at least two years of full-time, post-undergraduate professional work experience.

(Please note: Internship experience is not counted towards the two years of professional work experience.)



While previous full-time work experience in the industry is preferred, it is not necessary to be currently employed within the media and entertainment industry.

Mentor Commitment

T. Howard Foundation mentors must be available to their assigned mentee(s) over the designated internship period. Mentors commit to:

- connecting with their mentee(s) **at least twice per month**,
- **meeting with their mentee face-to-face** at least one time during the internship period if the mentor is located in the same city as the mentee, and
- participating in an informational interview conducted by their mentee(s).
