Workshop presenter **Bruce Bramlett** specializes in Holocaust education and teacher training. He will also provide an overview of JPEF's online learning opportunities, and introduce the Educator Toolkit gifted to every participant.

At 12 years old, Jewish partisan **Ted Winestone** (born Tevye Wejnsztejn) escaped from a labor camp in Dworzec, Poland. For nearly two years, he fought against the Germans with various partisan groups. He suffered through the bitter cold winters, was plagued by frostbite, and was confronted daily by the rampant anti-Semitism of the non-Jewish partisans in the brigade. Ted Winestone is a long time resident of Memphis, TN and will share his story.
