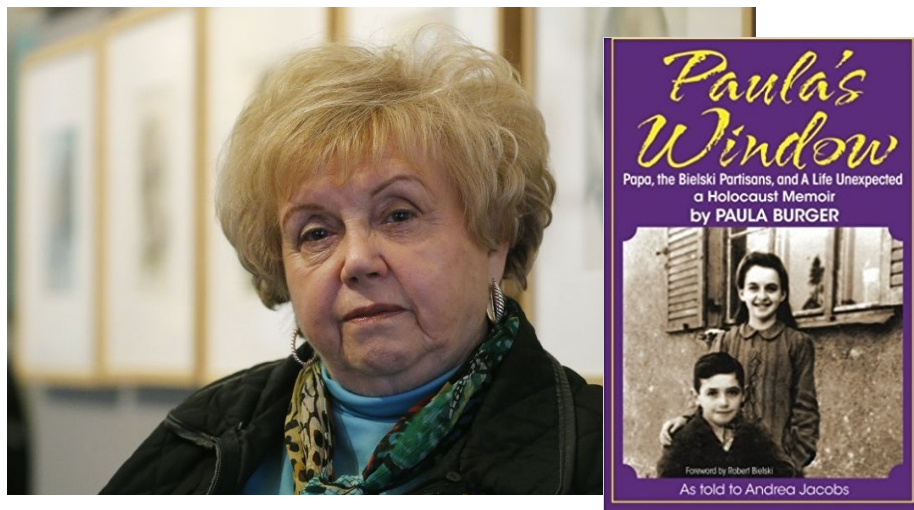
### “The Bielski Partisans, A Life Unexpected” Featuring Holocaust Survivor Paula Burger
