**1** Divisions will be broken down based on the number of competitors on the day of the event.

**2** Black belts are included in Advanced Divisions.

**3** 41 & up division will be broken down to over 50 if there are enough participants in the division.

NOTE: Any division with fewer than four (4) competitors may be combined with a division closest in size and/or rank level. Any division with more than ten (10) competitors may be divided into smaller divisions. All final decisions will be made by the tournament coordinator.

# COMPETITION EVENTS

<b>TRADITIONAL FORMS</b>	Any traditional martial arts form is accepted.	<b>POWER HAND BREAKING</b>	Stanchion breaking with downward hand strike. Scoring is based on the actual number of boards broken. Tie-breakers will be based on percentage of boards broken. Tournament officials will provide the stanchion for this event. Boards must be purchased at the tournament venue the day of competition to ensure fairness.
<b>CREATIVE FORMS</b>	Competitor creates their own martial arts form. Music is permitted but not mandatory.	<b>POWER SIDE KICK BREAKING</b>	Scoring is based on the actual number of boards broken. Tie-breakers will be based on percentage of boards broken. Tournament officials will provide the board holders for this event. Boards must be purchased at the tournament venue the day of competition to ensure fairness.
<b>CREATIVE BREAKING</b>	Breaking techniques performed at multiple stations. Competitors are required to provide their own holders. Breaking will be limited to boards only. A maximum of 5 stations will be permitted. Boards must be purchased at the tournament venue the day of the competition to ensure fairness.	<b>POWER BACK KICK BREAKING</b>	Scoring is based on the actual number of boards broken. Tie-breakers will be based on percentage of boards broken. Tournament officials will provide the board holders for this event. Boards must be purchased at the tournament venue the day of competition to ensure fairness.
<b>WEAPONS FORMS</b>	Both traditional and creative weapons forms are acceptable for this competition. Competitors are required to provide their own weapons. No live blades will be permitted.	<b>REPETITIVE SPEED HAND BREAKING</b>	Repetitive speed hand breaking will be a timed event. Competitors will break 10 boards as quickly possible with a downward hand strike. Scoring is based on the time taken to successfully break 10 boards. Boards must be broken one at a time. Tournament officials will provide the stanchion for this event. Boards must be purchased at the tournament venue the day of competition to ensure fairness.
