

NOVEMBER LUNCH AND LEARN EVENTS

Morrow, GA, October 12, 2017 – The Georgia Archives will host two Lunch and Learn Programs in November. Lunch and Learn Programs are free and open to the public. No registration is required.

On Friday, November 10, 2017, noon-1:00pm, Reference and Processing Archivists Allison Hudgins, Amanda Mros, Caroline Crowell and Jaimie Kicklighter will share their favorite collections from Georgia Archives holdings. These interesting, unusual, and sometimes under-utilized records provide researchers with critical information often not available anywhere else, and do so in fun and engaging ways. Archivists will describe these collections and share stories of previous and potential applications.

On Friday, November 17, 2017, noon-1:00pm, we will have a special Lunch and Learn program. Christine Garrett, Electronic Records Manager at the Georgia Archives, will present *Emergency Preparedness and Disaster Planning for Personal Records*. She will discuss identifying essential records – records of historical and sentimental value to families. She will also discuss records needed to recover from a disaster and how to protect records from a disaster before one happens.

The Georgia Archives identifies, collects, manages, preserves, provides access to, and publicizes records and information of Georgia and its people, and assists state and local government agencies with their records management.
