

# Is Your Criminal Record Preventing You From Getting A Job?

## Learn About the Pardon and Expungement Process At a 2-Hour Workshop



Individuals with criminal histories are often denied employment or fired from jobs because of their criminal pasts.

Sometimes, a conviction (and a guilty plea is a conviction) can be used to keep a person out of a job, but a person's arrest record should never serve as a basis for a denial of employment.
