Powerful Tools for Caregivers

Caring for a family member or friend with a chronic condition can be physically, emotionally, and financially draining. This highly effective, evidenced-based, self-care educational program for family caregivers, builds the skills caregivers need to take better care of themselves as they provide care for others. Caregiver participants learn to minimize the potentially negative impacts of caregiving in a 6-week program emphasizing self-care and empowerment. Registration is required for this 6-week course.

Health Literacy Presentation: Memory Loss & Communicating Effectively with Your Healthcare Provider

This is a 1-session, evidence-based workshop on how to navigate the increasingly complex healthcare field. In this interactive session, participants are empowered to become advocates for themselves, as well as their loved ones. The differences between normal aging and what may be a memory loss concern are covered as well.
