Who Should Attend: Early Head Start & Head Start staff, child care providers, home visitors (EHS, HFA, etc), early interventionists, case managers, mental health clinicians, and all others who work with children 0–5.

Training Overview: This beginning level training will help participants differentiate developmentally typical and atypical behaviors in young children, with a focus on children 2-5 years in home and classroom settings. Didactic lecture, group discussion, and interactive activities will be used to help participants recognize meaning behind behaviors, engage in self-reflection, identify triggers, and develop strategies for intervening with young children using strength-based behavioral and “bottom-up” approaches.
