Oct 4 – 11: Engaging the World Prayer Requests

George & Martha Mixon (Serge/Kenya): Please pray for the people of Kenya as the presidential election runoff takes place on October 26. Pray for wisdom as we choose among many great options for training church leaders in Bible storying in the coming months. Opportunities are springing up at the coast, among Maasai, in central province, in eastern province, in Nakuru and Nairobi, even in Tanzania. In November George and a couple of their trainers hope to go to the vast Kakuma refugee camp up on the border of Kenya and South Sudan. We are exploring a year-long training there for the scores of pastors of small churches in the camp of about 200,000 displaced people from South Sudan, Somalia, and other parts of Africa. Finally, pray for our Serge teams in Kenya. Martha and George truly need your prayers as they walk through many challenges with leaders of all the teams.

Paul & Missy Robelot (TEAM/France): Please pray for wisdom as they balance new ministry responsibilities. Pray that the Lord would equip and use them during member care facilitator training coming up later this month in Poland. Lastly, praise God for local church members being more and more involved in the church and with outreach events.

Peter & Diane Bakelaar (MTW/Japan): Pray for God to use the Unfolding exhibition to bring about networking and building relationships among artists in Nagoya.
