**Abortion care is under attack in Iowa.

Dear,

Today, Planned Parenthood and the ACLU of Iowa filed a lawsuit to protect access to abortion in Iowa. We asked the Polk County District Court to block a law that would force a 72-hour waiting period for Iowa women seeking abortions, effective immediately upon signing. Governor Branstad has announced he will sign the abortion restrictions into law at 8:30 a.m. on Friday, May 5.

The new abortion law will be implemented immediately upon Gov. Branstad's signing. Unless we receive the temporary injunction, the new law will immediately interrupt the appointments – and lives – of women already scheduled to have abortion procedures that day and on the following days.

This attack on women's health is outrageous, and we won't stand for it. We are working urgently to protect women as soon as the law is signed so our patients can get the care they need, when they need it.

This abortion restriction is among the harshest in the nation and puts a woman's health at risk by forcing her to have an abortion later in pregnancy. This risks women's health solely for political reasons, and that is simply unacceptable.

Please make an emergency gift now to help fund this fight for Iowa women.

Planned Parenthood will continue to fight for the right of every woman to make her own medical decisions, and I thank you for fighting with us – no matter what.
