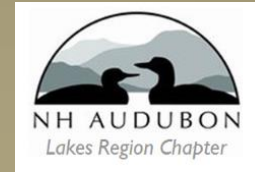


Primeval Forests of New Hampshire

When thinking of old growth or the pre-settlement forest that occupied the landscape of in New Hampshire, everyone seems to conjure their own distinct image.

You may expect all old growth stands to look like the Ewok forest from *Star Wars* containing towering trees with massive trunks.

In northern New England, the trees are not the massive leviathans like those in the Pacific Northwest; however, the primeval old growth forest has a certain primitive feel and offers a glimpse into the past. In addition, they often contain some very large trees.”
