

OSHA Delays Electronic Reporting Deadline

OSHA implemented a new rule in 2016 requiring certain employers, including those in high-hazard industries, to submit injury and illness reports electronically which were to be accessible by the public via a website. The form to be submitted is the Form 300A. The rule originally required submission of injury and illness logs no later than **July 1, 2017.**

Until now employers have been unable to submit injury and illness reports electronically on the OSHA website.

OSHA has announced it intends to **extend** the July 1, 2017 deadline by which certain employers were required to submit the information from their completed 2016 Form 300A electronically.
