#### Financial Review and Commentary

- June reversed a four-month slide in pledge revenue that had been under budget since January. June pledge revenue was on budget but YTD is still shy of budget by \$16K. Mid year pledge statements were mailed in early July.
- Clergy salaries were slightly over budget during June due to an error by the payroll company. The overage will be made up in future periods and will result in a timing variance.
- HVAC expense was high during June due to two AC issues. For the year HVAC is on budget. Lawn expense was also over budget due to a tree trimming project due to storm damage. The Jr Warden is researching ways to get back on budget.
- Cash is \$98K (all funds). There have been no borrowings on the line of credit.
- The Operating Fund balance at 6/30 was \$119K.
