Our high school students have an *amazing opportunity* to go to Haiti in March, 2018.

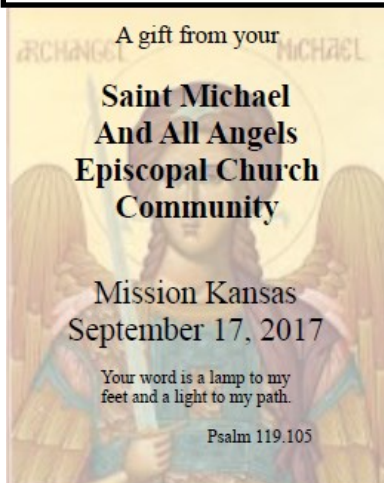
