As of November 5, we have 166 pledges totaling \$625,382. That is a solid start for our parish. Still, more than 100 "pledge units" of 2018 have yet to renew, or commit.

Pledged Income essentially provides the operating budget of the parish. It enables the Finance Committee and Vestry to align and allocate the expenses of parish staff, buildings and grounds, ministries and programs, Diocesan apportionment, debt repayment, and more. That important budget work is pending for 2019.

Fr. Brent's recent letter to parish members spoke to the financial challenge we face – and the urgency for us to answer that challenge. Thank you to all pledgers who have responded to the 2019 campaign call. The priority you have given your pledge is appreciated. A particular thank you to our newcomers and first-time pledgers.
