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The Delegate Scholarship Program was enacted into law by the Maryland General Assembly in 1957 (§ 18-501 of the Business Article, Annotated Code of Maryland). The Delegate Scholarship Program provides funds for enrollment in undergraduate, graduate or professional studies at approved colleges, universities and career (or vocational) schools in the State of Maryland.

Eligibility: You must apply annually for the Delegate Scholarship and meet the following criteria:

LIVE IN THE 29 B DISTRICT. Please go to http://mdelect.net to make sure **Delegate Rey** is *YOUR* Delegate. If she is, then please submit this application. If she is not, please contact your district delegate and senator for their specific scholarship applications. The main number to the Maryland General Assembly is (301) 858 – 3000.

COMPLETE AND FILE THE APPLICATION FOR A DELEGATE SCHOLARSHIP: The application package must be completed and filed electronically by the deadline **April 15, 2017**. The Scholarship Committee will not consider an incomplete or late application packages.

PLAN TO ATTEND A COLLEGE, UNIVERSITY, OR APPROVED CAREER SCHOOL LOCATED IN MARYLAND: The applicant must attend a college, university, or approved career school in the State of Maryland. The career school must have the approval of the Maryland Higher Education Commission to operate, and must be accredited by a national accrediting association approved by the United States Department of Education. Applicants may be eligible for scholarship assistance to attend out-of-state colleges or university if they are enrolling in an academic program which is not offered in a Maryland college or university. PLAN TO ATTEND SCHOOL FULL-TIME OR PART-TIME: Full-time attendance is defined as 12 credits per semester for undergraduate and 9 credits per semester for graduate students. Part-time attendance is defined as 6 to 11 credits per semester for undergraduates and 6 to 8 credits per semester for graduate students. **APPROVED CAREER SCHOOL:** Full-time attendance is defined as 18 or more clock hours per week. Part-time is defined as 9 to 17 clock hours per week.

Please Note: After you have submitted your application, there is no need to contact Delegate Rey's office as you will be notified no later than the end of June 2017 via mail, phone call, or personal visit to advise you of the decision by the Scholarship Committee of your award status.
