**Who is the Volunteer Hub for?**

The Volunteer Hub is a space specifically designed to encourage, equip, and support volunteers that are actively serving at firstChristian. So, it's just for you! The Volunteer!

**When is the Volunteer Hub available?**

The Volunteer Hub is available every time you serve before and after your serving time in room 114 (formerly known as the chapel).

**What are Volunteer Huddles?**

Volunteer huddles will happen each week unless otherwise noted, and are held before your serving time begins for 5-10 minutes.
