

3rd Annual Healing Voices OnStage: Caregivers' Stories



Submit your caregiver story to be woven together with others' stories as part of an original professional theater piece about the caregiver experience.

Short works of poetry, prose, theatrical scenes, memoir and creative non-fiction will be considered. In addition, two pieces will be selected for development into five to ten minute original scenes for the stage.

This project, produced in partnership with Writers Theatre of New Jersey and Premiere Stages at Kean University, will culminate with a professional presentation of selected works as part of New Jersey Theatre Alliance's Stages Festival.

A public showcase will feature readings of selected works by professional actors on March 23, 2018 at the Bickford Theatre at the Morris Museum in Morristown, New Jersey.

Entry Details:

All pieces should reflect the theme of caregiving.

Short works of poetry, prose, theatrical scenes, memoir and creative non-fiction will be considered.

- All entries must be typed and may be formatted in any way you like, as long as they follow the guidelines.
- Do not include images.
- All work must be submitted digitally.
- No more than three entries per author.
- All entries must be original works and must not have previously been published.
- Artistic License: In order to include as many authors as possible, the presenters may excerpt portions of larger works.

- This program is open to the public, including all employees, volunteers and medical staff members of Atlantic Health System.

Deadline: All stories must be submitted by January 16, 2018
