## CURRENT SITUATION

<b>Situation Summary:</b>	The fire has become less active on the northern flank. Fire is holding to the current perimeter and no additional fire spread is anticipated. Interior islands of fuel may continue to burn. Mop-up, strengthening of control lines, and fire suppression repair will continue on all flanks of the fire.
	<p><b>OREGON RESIDENTS:</b></p> <p>The following area in Jackson County will reduce to a Level 2 (yellow) "Be Set" evacuation notice:</p> <p>The area east of Interstate 5, covering Bureau of Land Management lands and private properties west of the Jackson-Klamath County line, north of the Oregon-California border, and south of a line that extends from the intersection of I-5 and the Mount Ashland Ski Road due east to the Jackson-Klamath County line.</p> <p>The following areas in Jackson County will reduce to a Level 1 (green) "Be Ready" evacuation notice:</p> <p>The area east of Interstate 5, covering Bureau of Land Management lands and private properties west of the Jackson-Klamath County line, north of the line that extends from the intersection of I-5 and the Mount Ashland Ski Road due east to the Jackson-Klamath County line, north to Highway 66.</p> <p>All other evacuations levels west of I-5 have been lifted.</p>
