Sonoma-Lake-Napa Unit Open House

St. Helena – Fire Prevention Week kicked off Sunday October 7th and runs through Saturday October 13th, 2018. CAL FIRE Sonoma-Lake-Napa Unit is teaming up with the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) to promote this year's Fire Prevention Week campaign "Look. Listen. Learn. Be aware. Fire can happen anywhere." Which works to educate the public about basic but essential ways to quickly and safely escape a home fire.

Remember these three easy things when making your home safe:

- **Look** for possible fire hazards in your home and eliminate them. Are your outlets overloaded? Check the circuit loads of your electrical appliances and devices and unplug when not in use. Inspect your appliance cords. If any are torn, ripped, or damaged in any way, replace them immediately. If a cord or plug ever feels hot, unplug it.
- **Listen** for the sound of the smoke alarm. Know that you may have only minutes to get out if a fire starts.
- **Learn** two ways out of every room. Exits should be easy to access and free of clutter. After leaving the home, go to your family's designated meeting spot that was created when you set up your home fire escape plan.

Sonoma-Lake-Napa Unit Chief Shana Jones would like to invite the public to visit one of your local CAL FIRE station on October 13th, 2018 where the community will have the opportunity step into a firefighter's world". Guests will view where firefighters train, work, eat and sleep when they are not responding to a local or statewide emergency incident.
