CURRENT SITUATION

Situation Summary:	Heavy smoke over the area has continued to significantly reduced fire activity. Fire spread remains fuels and topography driven with high potential for roll out and spot fires. Heavy timber fuels still challenge firefighting efforts. Battling terrain driven winds in proximity of the lake have complicated the predictability of this activity. The fire continues to burn actively within containment lines. Residents and the public are able to travel along State Route 299, however, they are asked to drive safely as fire crews and emergency personnel are still working in the area.
