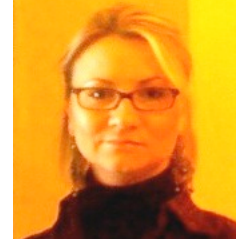

Ms. Olga Miller heads Renova USA, the representative office for the Renova Group of Companies in the United States, with prime focus on U.S.-Russia business development, philanthropy, public relations and government relations efforts. Prior to this appointment, Ms. Miller served as Director for U.S.-Russia Relations and Director for International Programs at Renova USA. Ms. Miller's responsibilities embrace advancing programs and initiatives among business, academe, arts and culture, policy and grassroots communities.

Ms. Miller has been instrumental in developing the Renova Group's USA strategic communications and public relations programs and has implemented numerous attendant projects. In 2004 and 2005, Ms. Miller's hands-on involvement helped facilitate a widely-noted Faberge acquisition from Sotheby's auction house in New York. Her efforts at worldwide arts and culture events proved critical for the ensuing program's success. From 2008 through 2016 her close involvement in the St. Danilov Monastery Bells, White Nights Foundation, Carnegie Hall, and, most recently, Fort Ross projects helped advance Renova's efforts at enhancing U.S.-Russia cultural relations. She has been involved in a number of initiatives with the United Nations, Trust for Mutual Understanding, Philanthropy New York, Stanford U.S.-Russia Forum, Clinton Global Initiative, as well as some key initiatives with RAND Corporation and US-Russia Business Council to promote better understanding between the United States and Russia.

Ms. Miller has broad professional experience in the United States, Russia, Europe and Central Asia. In the past, she executed analyses of diverse Russian NGOs for international development and investment grants, prepared analyses of broad non-profit operational activity, and served as an international development consultant for Russian NGOs in Europe. She has authored several pieces on Russian identity and migration in the FSU, international negotiation and conflict resolution. She travels widely and speaks fluent English, Russian and German.

Ms. Miller holds a Masters in Global Affairs from New York University and Bachelors in Intercultural Communication from a private Russian university. She is married and has three children.
