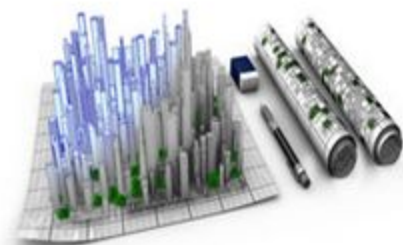
Architect's Studio – Draw It-Design It-Build It

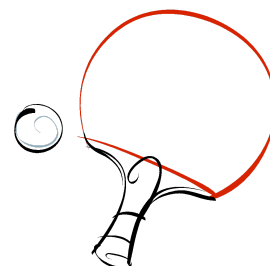


Table Tennis
