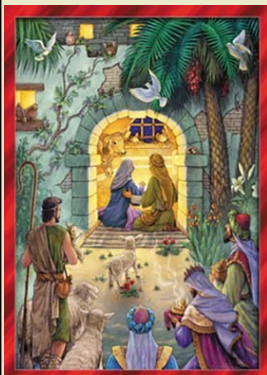

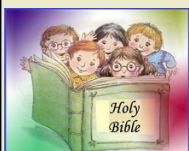
### Christmas Eve Services:

**9:00 p.m.**- which will include Candlelight and music by our choir.

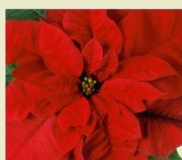

**Pledges**—Our stewardship season is drawing to a close and we still have a few members we have not heard from. If you have yet to make a pledge for the 2018 -

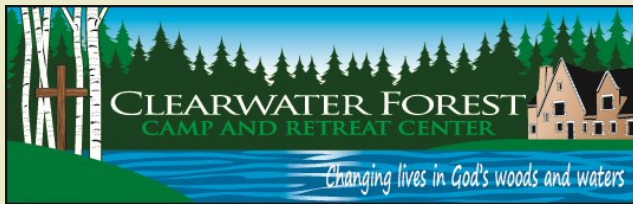
