Did you know that 500 children in our community in the Plymouth/Wayzata area are at risk of entering kindergarten behind? **Bloom Early Learning and Child Care Center**

is addressing the challenge of early learning for all children by providing affordable childcare. Bloom was founded in the late nighties as a response to the Welfare to Work Program. The members of Messiah Methodist Church began to wonder if all the mothers who were going to work had safe and affordable childcare for their children. They developed a mission; serving children from 6 weeks to age 5 and their families. Half of their capacity is dedicated to families needing financial assistance.

Currently, the Bloom Early Learning and Child Care Center is at capacity. They are now looking to expand their program to help reach those 500 children in our area who are not being served. That is where Plymouth Presbyterian Church comes in. We are blessed with a building that can house three classrooms to accommodate the Bloom expansion. Welcoming Bloom Early Learning and Child Care into our church building would become an intentional and continual mission of our church and not a direct source of income.

What this means is if we are willing to:

- Donate shared space for Bloom to use as classrooms
- Participate in Bloom activities and curriculum


