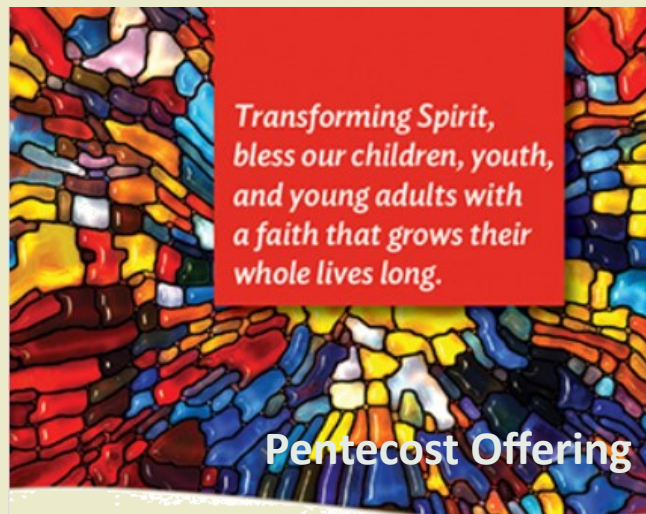

NHS creates a safe space where girls and women who have been exploited by sex trafficking and the sex trade can find rest, a place to think, refreshment and connections to services and support that will get them from where they are now to where they want to be in life. Standing on the front steps of NHS, you are standing one block away from the corner of Broadway and Emerson, on one of the busiest sex-trade corners on the Northside of Minneapolis.

NHS offers trauma support groups, youth violence prevention Workshops, parenting classes, yoga, African Dance and Zumba, and ministry to millennials.
