Note: All outside glass on both services will be treated with a rain repellent.

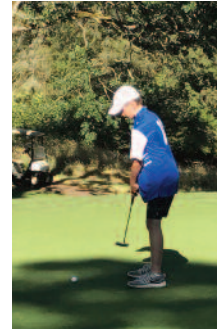

PXG Demo day was a big hit and Jason the Master Fitter for PXG was very pleased with the turnout. If you ever decide you would like anything in their line, he will come and do a one on one with you.

New to the center as well is the Callaway Epic and Epic Pro irons for you to try. These two along with other iron sets are available for you to take out on the course to try before make you order them. Please keep in mind it is best to return any borrowed item to the center after each round so they are available for other members.

If you haven't heard we also now have the Edel putter fitting system in the Performance and Fitting Center. Edel makes one of the best putters on the market simply because they are handmade custom for you at the time of order from now into August.

What a way to start off a new month! Three days with 100 degree plus days. Good news, balls go a lot further. We also will hopefully have the rest of the days with good weather. What a way to end a great summer.

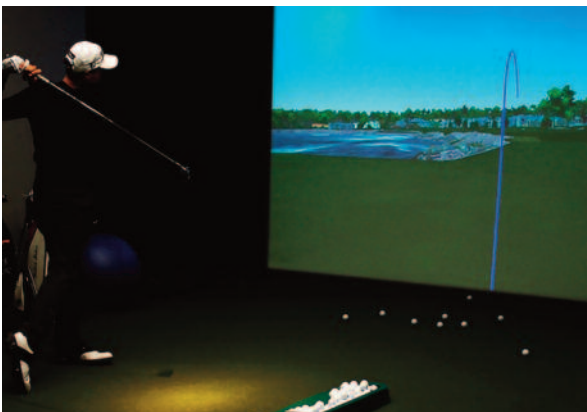

# AROUND THE GREENS

The "Dog Days of Summer" are here...as I write this month's newsletter we are heading towards 54 days with no measurable rain. This is the time of year that turf grass really starts showing signs of stress. The long hot days with no rainfall really start to bring to light any issues that your front lawn or a golf course might have. I know we typically put the blame on lack of water or "doughtiness" however, in many cases that is not always the issue.

When we see turf in any situation, whether its greens, tees, fairways or even your front yard, that is dying there is some sort of stress that the plant is undergoing to cause it to die. This stress can be caused by all sorts of outside pressure or various issues. Here is a short list that I came up with:

Outside Pressure: 1 – Weather 2 – Disease 3 – Insects

Various Issues: 1 – Poor Irrigation or Drought Stress 2 – Compacted Soil 3 – Low Fertility

4 – Poor pH 5 – Shade 6 – Shallow Rooting

Creekside's fairways have a variety of these issues that will slowly be corrected over time as we continue our fairway program.

**Insect Control:** The European Crane Fly larva was by far the most obvious issue that was doing damage to the turf. This insect lays its eggs in the thatch of the grass which later hatches into a larva which loves to eat the roots of turf grass. Here is the larva that came to the surface when we sprayed in early spring as seen in the picture to the right.



In the picture above you will notice a graphic illustration of crane fly larva damage at the beginning of #16 fairway in the rough. The turf in the rough is extremely patchy with dead grass due to the roots being eaten. The fairway was sprayed and sees little if any damage. This is a great example of outside pressure on the turf grass plant.

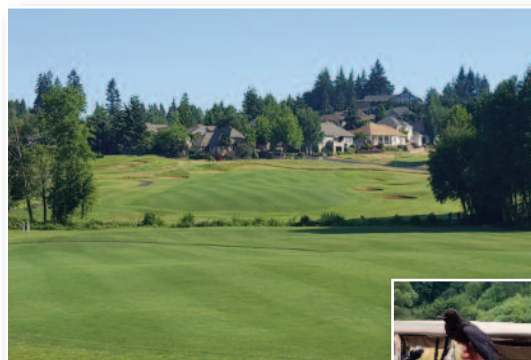
**Wetting Agents to Help with Drought Stress:** Wetting agents are products that we apply that help break down surface tension and promote water retention in the soil. Creekside has a very heavy clay type soil structure. When this soil turns dry from hot summer weather it turns hard as a rock. Water applied to this soil wants to just run off and not soak into the profile. We began applying wetting agents on the fair-

ways the first week of May and have applied each month thereafter. The results are what you see in the picture below that illustrates drought stress in the late afternoon on #16 fairway. This is some very healthy grass that is showing signs of stress from 97 degree temperature. This is the kind of turf grass health that we want...at night the soil will absorb the water and tomorrow morning it will bounce back after the evening irrigation.

**Growth Regulators and Seed Suppressants:** These specialized products have helped the golf industry tremendously. Both of these types of products help suppress the top growth of the plant (leaf blades and seed production) and allow the energy that would have been used to grow the grass blade or seed head to be used towards root growth and drought tolerance. The end result is turf grass that has developed better rooting, has more density, and can handle more stress brought on by summer time temperatures.

All of these components are not a onetime fix or silver bullet to give you great fairways. It is all part of a turf grass program. When these products are incorporated into the overall maintenance program and are coupled with correct timing and fertilization they can help produce fairways that are healthy and appealing to golfers.

**Reminder:** Please help us maintain our course as you play your round. Remember to replace your divot especially if it has substantial soil. Also, please repair your ball marks on the putting surface. If we all do our part it makes our golfing experience enjoyable for everyone.
