Simulator Golf League Rules
Winter Best Ball Championship

“One best ball of partners net. There will be 2 flights (Men & Women)
“You will get to play 3 courses in a 2 Month time frame, starting January 2nd
thru Feb. 28th

“The lowest score to par after the two months will be the winner!
“You will have a two and a half hour time limit on your round per 2 some.
Please don't delay getting your rounds in...it will be a STRICT deadline, make sure you pace yourself and get your rounds completed. Please call the golf shop to reserve your time. We will only be able to accommodate rounds past normal shop hours (7am-5pm) by reservation only at least 24 hours in advance.

The courses used will be:
Banff Springs (Canada)
Cabo del Sol-The Ocean Course(Mexico)
Frankfurter Golf Club (Germany)

Men will play from the "amateur" tees and the ladies from the "forward" tees.
For the putting aspect, it will be on auto score for all rounds.

Cost is \$40 per player

Payouts will be based on Participation
