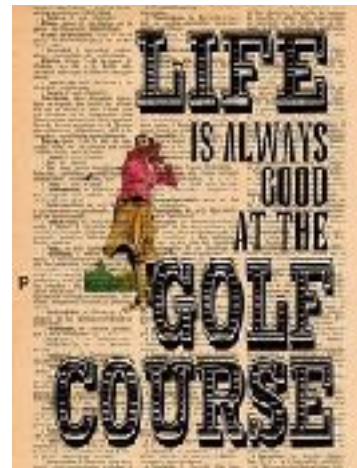

The OGA Women's Inter-club Play (WIP):

The WIP program is a four-ball match play competition between clubs for women only. Each match consists of 6 players per club team playing another club's team within their division. The 6 players per team are then divided into pairs to play other club twosomes and matched by handicap.

The OGA 2017 Women Inter-club Play schedule is:

Championship & Season-ending Finale: October date to be determined.

Once all teams are registered, the OGA will decide which division each club is in for the season. Team captains will be meeting on April 19th to receive additional information and rules. The fee remains the same, \$40 to play each match.
