Adult Christian Formation

Outreach

Food Pantry - At our Easter distribution we served 46 families totaling 171 people, 54 of whom were children under the age of 18. Thank you to volunteers who donated money toward the purchase of hams, unloaded and shelved groceries, set up bags, bagged the groceries, bought eggs and milk, did clerical work, and helped with the distribution. Working together, with God's help, we can do marvelous things!

Redeemer Quilters - Last week we gave 20 walker pockets to Our Lady of Sorrows and Anne Buffington offered to take 40 pockets to Charlotte Hall. There are more pockets. If you know of someone with a walker who could use a pocket to carry things, please take one from either the Brick Church or the Chapel. Also, this ministry depends on donated upholstery or drape material. We welcome all donations. The quilters meet on Friday mornings from 9:30 until noon. Everyone is welcome.

All Hallows Yarn Ministry - Our yarn angels have been busy. New yarn, baby hats, and children's hats with scarves were donated this past month. Thank you.

Picture and Easy-to-Read Books -- We are again collecting children's books for the diocese-

sponsored reading enrichment summer camps. Last year we donated 111 books to this program.
