

A Call for Prayer on the 10th, 20th and 30th of the Month

On the occasion of the International General Council Meeting this coming June 14-16th, a new program will be launched proposing a common prayer for all those who share in the Vincentian vocation: in the year when we celebrate the 100th anniversary of the appearance of Our Lady of Fatima (May 13 to October 13), the 400th anniversary of the Vincentian Charism (September 27) and the 20th anniversary of Ozanam's beatification (August 22).

The spirit of this initiative is to motivate each member of the SSVP to take 15 minutes every 10th, 20th and 30th day of each month to ask the intercessions of our Lady of Fatima, St. Vincent and Bl. Ozanam for the prayer intentions of the poor, for ourselves, for our families and for the other members of the SSVP.

May our prayers serve to commit ourselves more fully to the Lord, through the spiritual union of all members of the SSVP and our families, along with the poor, "our masters", as Saint Vincent de Paul used to say.
