Rebekah A. Wood received her Ph.D. from Tennessee Technological University in 2004. She has been a Board Certified Behavior Analyst Doctoral Level since 2005 and is approved by the Behavior Analyst Certification Board (BACB) to serve as a supervisor for qualified candidates seeking to become Board Certified Behavior Analysts. Dr. Wood is currently serving as the Clinical Director of Aptitude Habilitation Services, which is a ABA Therapy Provider located in multiple locations across the United States and serves children and adults diagnosed with Autism Spectrum Disorder. She additionally serves as the Director of Behavioral Services for Modell Consulting Group, LLC providing consultation and supervision services across the United States as well as in Singapore and Indonesia. Previously, Dr. Wood spent over 10 years with the Tennessee Department of Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities as an approved Provider of Behavior Analyst Services, Director of the Middle Tennessee Regional Office Behavior Analyst Department and most recently as the State Director of Protection from Harm. Dr. Wood has served as a behavior consultant for pre-school aged children, teacher of an inclusive classroom, principal of an alternative school serving adolescents in the custody of the state, and adjunct professor for the College of Education at Tennessee Technological University.
