The town was buried when the nearby and supposedly extinct volcano, Vesuvius, erupted in 79 AD, covering the town and its inhabitants in many tons of pumice and volcanic ash. Tour excavations with a local guide and get an intact vision of daily life in Roman society. This afternoon: transfer to Rome. Your tour manager will assist you in planning your free time to explore the city. **B**
