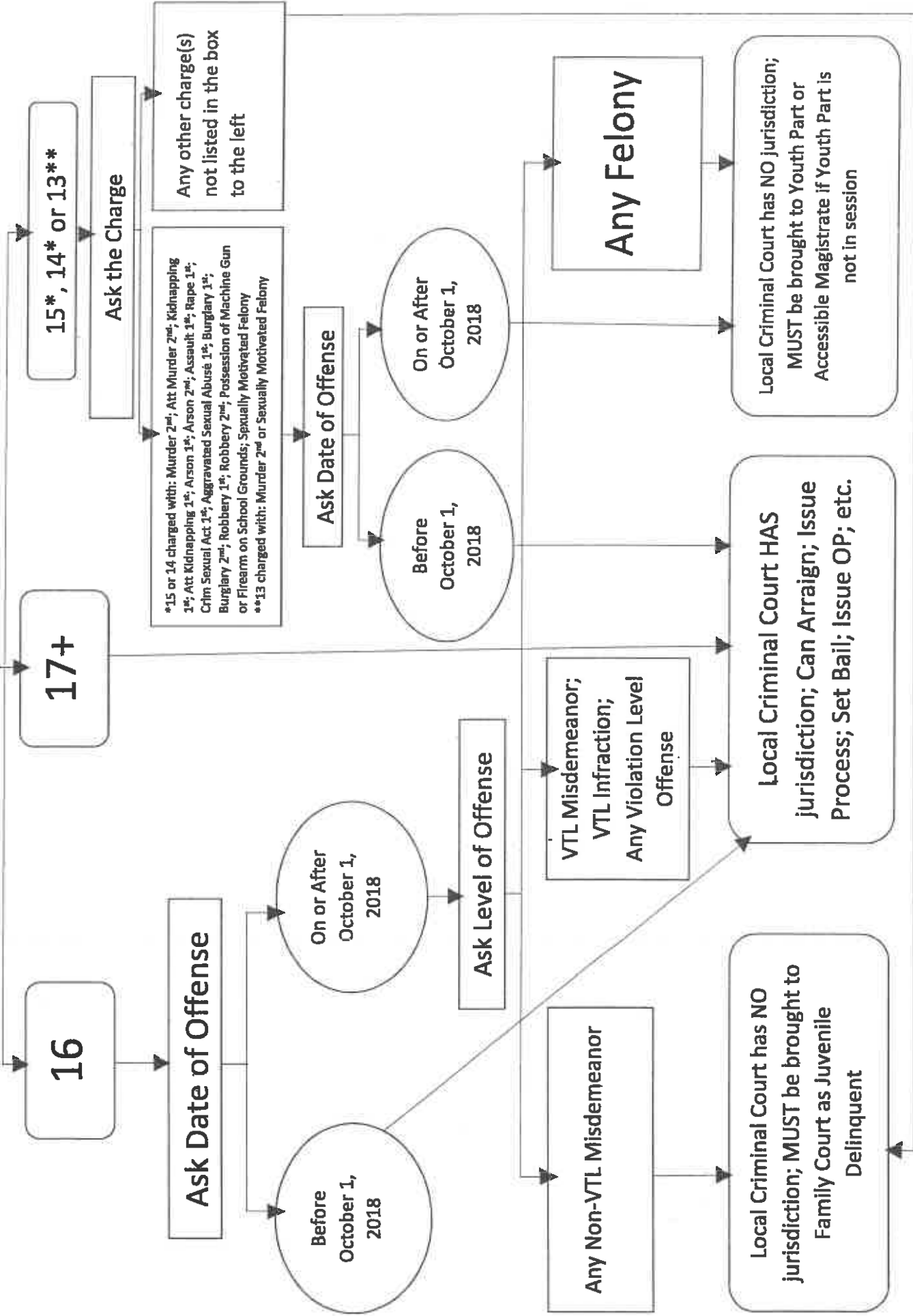


Raise the Age Jurisdiction Flowchart for Justice Courts – Effective October 1, 2018 to September 30, 2019

*15 or 14 charged with: Murder 2nd; Att Murder 2nd; Kidnapping 1st; Att Kidnapping 1st; Arson 1st; Arson 2nd; Assault 1st; Rape 1st; Crim Sexual Act 1st; Aggravated Sexual Abuse 1st; Burglary 1st; Burglary 2nd; Robbery 1st; Robbery 2nd; Possession of Machine Gun or Firearm on School Grounds; Sexually Motivated Felony
 **13 charged with: Murder 2nd or Sexually Motivated Felony

Local Criminal Court has NO jurisdiction; MUST be brought to Youth Part or Accessible Magistrate if Youth Part is not in session

Local Criminal Court HAS jurisdiction; Can Arraign; Issue Process; Set Bail; Issue OP; etc.

Local Criminal Court has NO jurisdiction; MUST be brought to Family Court as Juvenile Delinquent

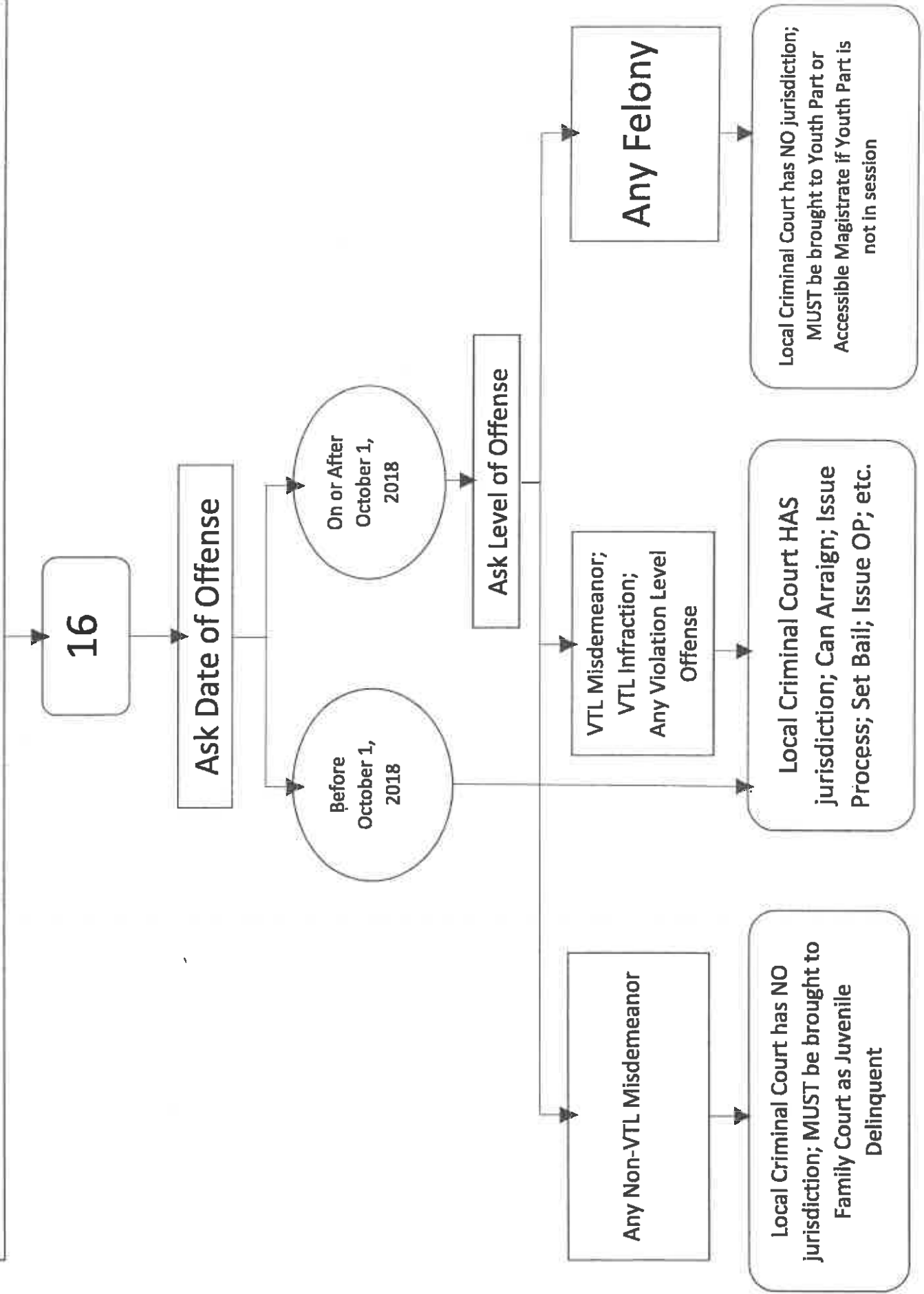

Ask the Charge

15 or 14 charged with: Murder 2nd; Att Murder 2nd; Kidnapping 1st; Att Kidnapping 1st; Arson 1st; Arson 2nd; Assault 1st; Rape 1st; Crim Sexual Act 1st; Aggravated Sexual Abuse 1st; Burglary 1st; Burglary 2nd; Robbery 1st; Robbery 2nd; Possession of Machine Gun or Firearm on School Grounds; Sexually Motivated Felony
