GEAC, Inc. (Georgia Education Advancement Council) is a state-wide organization, founded in 1977, for those at public, private and technical colleges and universities who work in educational advancement including the areas of alumni, development, advancement services, public relations/public affairs, and communications.

Scholarship Premise:

The GEAC Board of Directors established the GEAC Annual Conference Scholarship Program in early 2015 to provide two professionals, within the field of higher education, the opportunity to attend the annual GEAC conference on scholarship.

Who Is Encouraged To Apply:

- Professionals who have not attended a GEAC conference in the past
- New professionals (1-3 years) within alumni, development, advancement services, public relations/public affairs or communications at a college or university
- Professionals who work at campuses with limited resources for professional development

Application Process:

- Applications are due **September 30, 2016**
- The GEAC Board of Directors will review all applications and notify recipients. Recipients must use the scholarship for the 2016 Annual GEAC Conference at DeSoto Hilton Savannah.
- In the event the scholarship recipient cannot attend the conference, the board may award the scholarship to another applicant

What Is Covered:

- Annual Conference registration fee of \$275.00
- Single occupancy room for the duration of the annual conference (the nights of November 16-18, 2016)

What Is Not Covered:

- Mileage and all expenses (gas, food, etc.) pertaining to traveling to and from the location
- Hotel amenities such as room service, movie rentals, phone calls and any food consumed outside of the conference programs and events
- Extended nights at the hotel prior to/following the conference
