**Show Rules**

1. The Western Dairy Classic is open to junior exhibitors 5 years of age by January 1, 2017 and not yet 21 by the same date, thus an exhibitor must have been born during the years 1996 through 2012.
2. In Registered divisions, the owner on the registration certificate must match the exhibitor on the entry form.
3. All Holsteins need to be at least 87% Registered Holstein Ancestry and be registered with Holstein Association USA to be shown in the Registered Holstein Division.
4. All Jerseys must be registered with the American Jersey Cattle Association to be shown in the Registered Jersey Division. Eligible animals must have a GREEN certificate with no prefix or BLUE certificate and J4, J5, or J6. Not eligible animals include animals with a GREEN certificate with GR prefix, BLUE certificate and J1, J2, or J3 or GOLD certificate. No eligible animals can be shown in the Grade Division.
5. Management reserves the final and absolute right to interpret the rules and regulations and to arbitrarily settle questions and differences pertaining to the Western Dairy Classic Show.
6. With the exception of loading/unloading, there will be no parking on the fairgrounds. Please park in designated parking lots. This is to be in compliance with new parking rules enforced by the Kings Fairgrounds.
7. Exhibitors are expected to allow the use of their animals for the Judging Contest if so asked. Every effort will be made to use animals entered by willing participants.
8. The show uniform shall consist of a Shirt/Blouse with collar or a Western Classic t-shirt (no tank tops or t-shirts other than a Western Classic t-shirt) and white pants. 4-H and FFA uniforms are acceptable but not required.
