

# Historic Weston Orchard & Vineyard Brings Back the Apples



Erik Olson (above) talked about his apple trellising system while pruning on a warm, sunny Friday last March. The trees are spaced three feet apart, with 12 feet between rows.

“There are no permanent branches,” he said. “Once they get to the diameter of a quarter, we make a diagonal cut and a new limb comes out at the bottom of the cut.”

The goal is to have five apples per limb, 20 limbs per tree, which will equal one bushel per tree. The dwarf trees are trained vertically along bamboo sticks and have a 20 to 25 year life span.

“Using dwarfs makes for pedestrian-friendly picking,” he said. “It also lends itself to mechanization of picking and pruning. “It takes the ladder out of the equation.”

Once famous for its sprawling apple orchards, the Weston area had lost all its orchards to fire blight, trees that aged out and the high cost of maintenance.

Two years ago, Erik Olsen stepped in and brought them back in a big way. His is already one of the largest U-Pick Orchards.

The Nebraska native started

planting his orchard on 48 acres just north of the Weston city limits (on Washington/Hwy. H) in 2015. Since then, he’s planted thousands of apple, peach and cherry trees, blackberry canes and strawberries.

“I picked Weston because of the love of history, Applefest and I wanted to start something in a real community,” he said. “This

has given us the opportunity to do something as a family together.”

His father and his older son have helped with the planting, pruning and other jobs at the orchard. He and his wife and four children are becoming part of the community.

“I want people to learn about agriculture and where food comes from,” he said. “This will give people a place to come and learn about food as a family. They can also have a lot of fun.”

In addition to the picking, There is a corn maze, hayrides, kettle corn, a “Bale Mountain, Colorado Rat Racer, a low-rope obstacle course, and Spider web.

In addition to 13 varieties of apples, the orchard has a pumpkin patch where you can literally pick the one(s) you want.

It should be apparent now that this isn’t your grandfather’s apple orchard.

The dwarf trees were planted three feet apart and trellised. “High density orchards are common in other areas. I think that’s the way to go.”

Advantages are that people can pick almost the entire tree and no ladders are involved. They also will produce sooner than full-sized trees.

This year, the harvest began. Now it’s apples, but first up were U-Pick strawberries. Blackberries and peaches were ready in mid July. From mid August to the first of November, the picking is apples.

Mr. Olson has broken ground for his main building, and will finish it after the picking season is over. The kitchen inside will be for making pies, caramel apples and apple dumplings, There will also be jams, salsas, apple cider, pies, wines, apple brandy, fudge and a host of other goodies.

Mr. Olson has worked in orchards since 1997, including as manager of Kimmel Orchard and the Arbor Day Farm at Nebraska City, Nebraska.

“We’re just proud to bring apples back to Weston,” he said. “Weston has a long history of orchards.

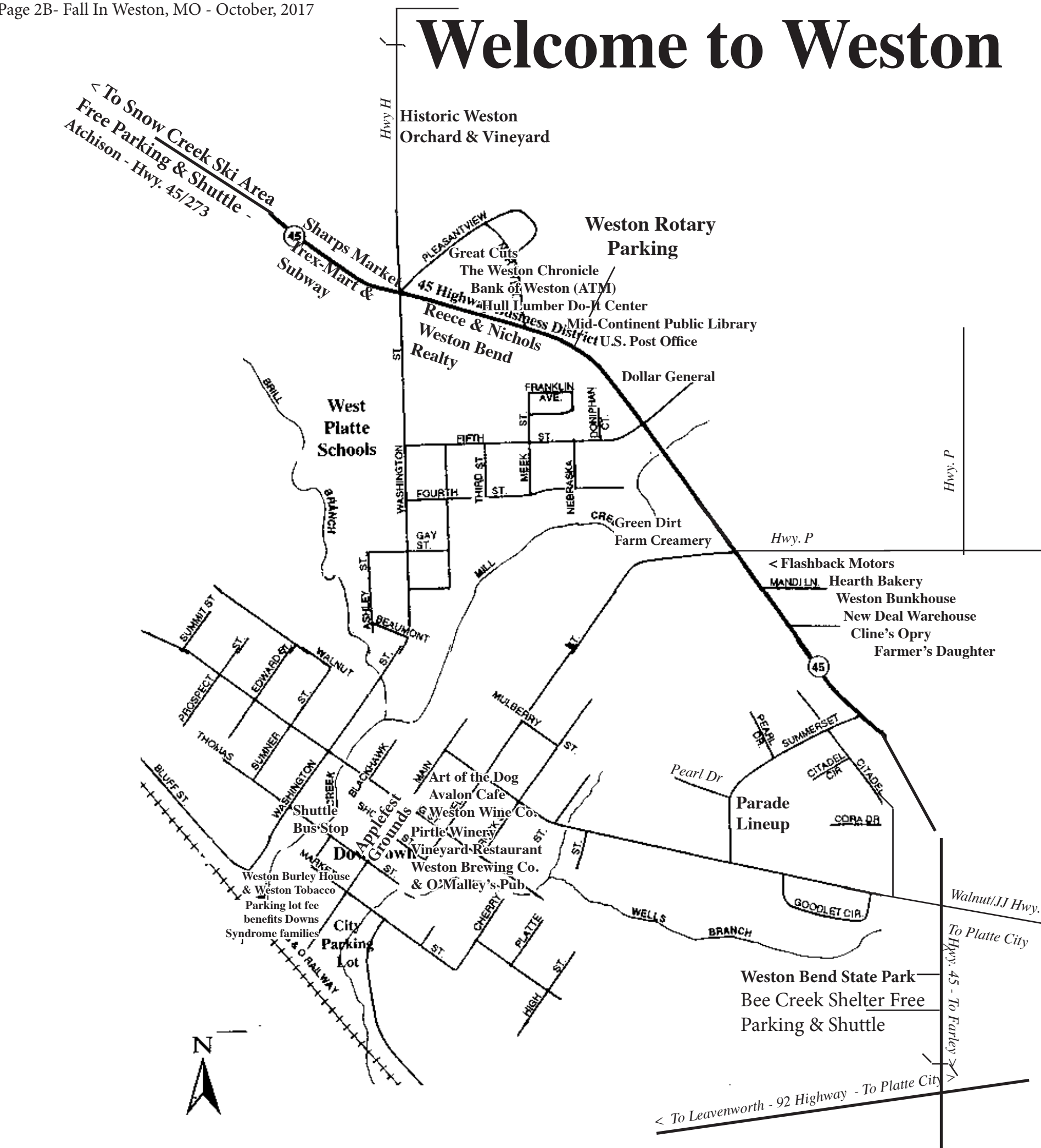
“We want to see people enjoying themselves. There’s enough chaos in the world. This gives people the chance to do things together, unplug and get back to nature.”
