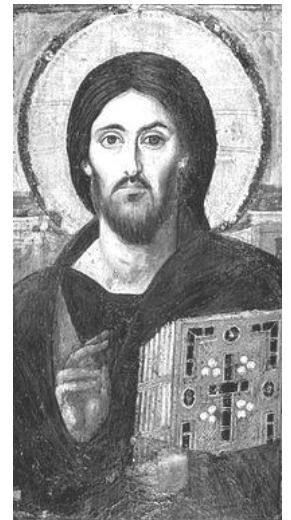
## ***This Week at Memorial***

**Special Icon Workshop Coming to Memorial, September**

**10<sup>th</sup> - 14<sup>th</sup>!** Icons are visual representations of invisible realities meant to help us understand spiritual truths and aid in worship and prayer. During this 5-day workshop, instructor Kara Nelson will lead participants in the prayerful practice of "writing" a Byzantine style icon. This is a step-by-step process in which we recreate ancient and sacred images using acrylic paints and 23-carat gold. Through silence and sharing, work and rest, prayers and meals, we create a unique community, and together invite the Holy Spirit to work in and through us as we paint the holy image of Christ (shown at left). The course fee is \$300 per person for 5 full days of instruction and includes all supplies for painting as well as a midday meal. Class will be held each day from 8:30AM-4:30PM. This workshop is open to all and does not require previous art experience. Space is limited.
