One of the themes of Two River's upcoming production, *Hurricane Diane*, is climate change. To dive deeper into this theme, the Two River Theater has partnered with the Monmouth Community Climate Coalition to bring you Mother Earth vs. World's People - a 40 minute mock trial which invites the audience, serving as the trial jury, to decide whether Mother Earth has made her case.

Following the trial, *Hurricane Diane* playwright Madeleine George, along with Tony MacDonald, Director, Urban Coast Institute, Monmouth University and Monmouth Community Climate Coalition founding member, Lynn Dash, will answer questions and lead a discussion that explores ways to learn more about climate change and how to share what we learn through the arts, education and involvement in local community organizations.

The mock trial will be read by Two River Theater's Metro Scholars - a highly talented group of high school juniors, currently immersed in professional acting workshops and internships at the theater.
