This spring has been one of anticipation and waiting. Silas, CJ and I were able to go down to work on the new coffee shop in Ih Uul for a couple of weeks in a row. We removed all of the paneling on the walls and ceilings, and removed half of the upstairs flooring to create a balcony. There was 10 years of dirt and dust collected inside the spaces in between the paneling and log walls, not to mention above the 1st floor ceiling... and we hauled off about 5 flatbed truck loads of wood and dirt! We have had a lot of curious attention from the people in town. Everyone we have met has been up to see the foundation we laid for our home last fall, and people are excited to see how Americans will build a cabin in Mongolia.

Covid-19 finally visited our province in the beginning of March, and for about 9 weeks, we weren't able to drive down to work on either building, since the highways in our country were closed. The church here in Hatgal is still meeting online, and our coffee shop had to start working according to emergency protocols. We are still able to operate, but we had to take out the majority of our seating, and rearrange the tables so that everyone could sit 2 meters apart.

Please continue to pray for the church as they minister to the community online. There is much hope that by July 1st, the country will open up as people get vaccinated. Miigaa has been meeting with small groups for discipleship and building up the worship team. Everyone is excited to meet again in person and worship and serve together.

We are always so thankful for your prayers and support! This August 1st will mark our 14th year serving in Mongolia! It's an honor to serve the Lord among so many amazing people, and I pray that God will continue to use us to show people how they can have new life in Christ!
