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This Draft Test is sanctioned by the Working Dog Committee of the Newfoundland Club of America.

Entry Limit

This test is limited to a minimum of 3 entries in each testing division (BDD, DD). There will be a maximum of 15 total entries (a team counts as a single entry), regardless of division entered and regardless of how many entries are received for each division. Entries over this limit will be placed on an alternate list. Openings will be filled as specified by the NCA Draft Test Regulations. Priority will be given to entries that have not earned titles in the division entered. Titled dogs may be entered for judging (requalification) if the entry limit has not been filled. No post entry of teams will be accepted.

Saturday, March 13th the divisions will be BDD followed by DD.

Sunday, March 14th the divisions will be DD followed by BDD.

Please note that due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic and subsequent events beyond our control, this test is subject to cancellation. Refunds are not guaranteed.

Entry Fee

Entry fees are \$45 per entry (teams are a single entry). Please make checks payable to the Newfoundland Club of San Diego or NCSD.

Entry Opening and Closing Dates

Entries open for NCA members on February 8, 2021 and open for non-NCA members on February 18, 2021. Entries of NCA members received after February 18th will not be given priority over those of non-NCA members. Entries postmarked prior to February 8th for NCA members and February 18th for non-NCA members will not be accepted. Entries will be accepted by online entry <https://www.ncanews.org/wdc/> and by mail and must show a visible postmark. If you send entries via next day mail, please sign the "Waiver of Signature" space.

Closing date for receipt of entries is Wednesday, March 1 at 6:00 pm.

Online Entry Information

The Newfoundland Club of San Diego will be using the new online registration program for this event. Online registration is OPTIONAL but your participation will help the NCA perfect this new program. The online registration system is very user friendly.

Entries for this test will be accepted through the NCA's online registration service at <https://www.ncanews.org/wdc/> as well as through the traditional paper method. Entries submitted electronically will be assigned a postmark with the same date the entry is entered. Entries submitted by mail will be assigned the postmark given as per usual. Entries submitted electronically and via post will be considered equally in date order for slots in the test.

NCA members will have the same early-entry window with both paper entry and electronic entry. If you are not a member of the NCA you will be prompted to provide the same contact information that you would provide on a paper entry once entries are open to non-NCA members.

You will be prompted to enter or verify your dog's information and you will have the opportunity to upload an image of your dog's registration certificate. Please have an electronic version of your dog's registration form ready for upload before you begin the online entry process. Required Forms

The Newfoundland Club of America requires a photocopy of each dog's AKC registration with entry.

Bitches in Season

Bitches in season will be allowed to participate, but will be judged after all other entries have completed the entire test. Please notify the test secretary as soon as possible if you anticipate your bitch will be in season. Bitches that have had an ovarian sparing spay are required to be tested as bitches in season.

Dog Safety

The dogs' safety as well as the handlers' and judges' safety is our top priority. Dogs that are left in cars must have proper ventilation. Trudie Strumwasser, our safety officer, will be notified of any dogs that are left in cars so that she can make sure the dog is not overheating. All dogs must be on leash or securely crated when not working.

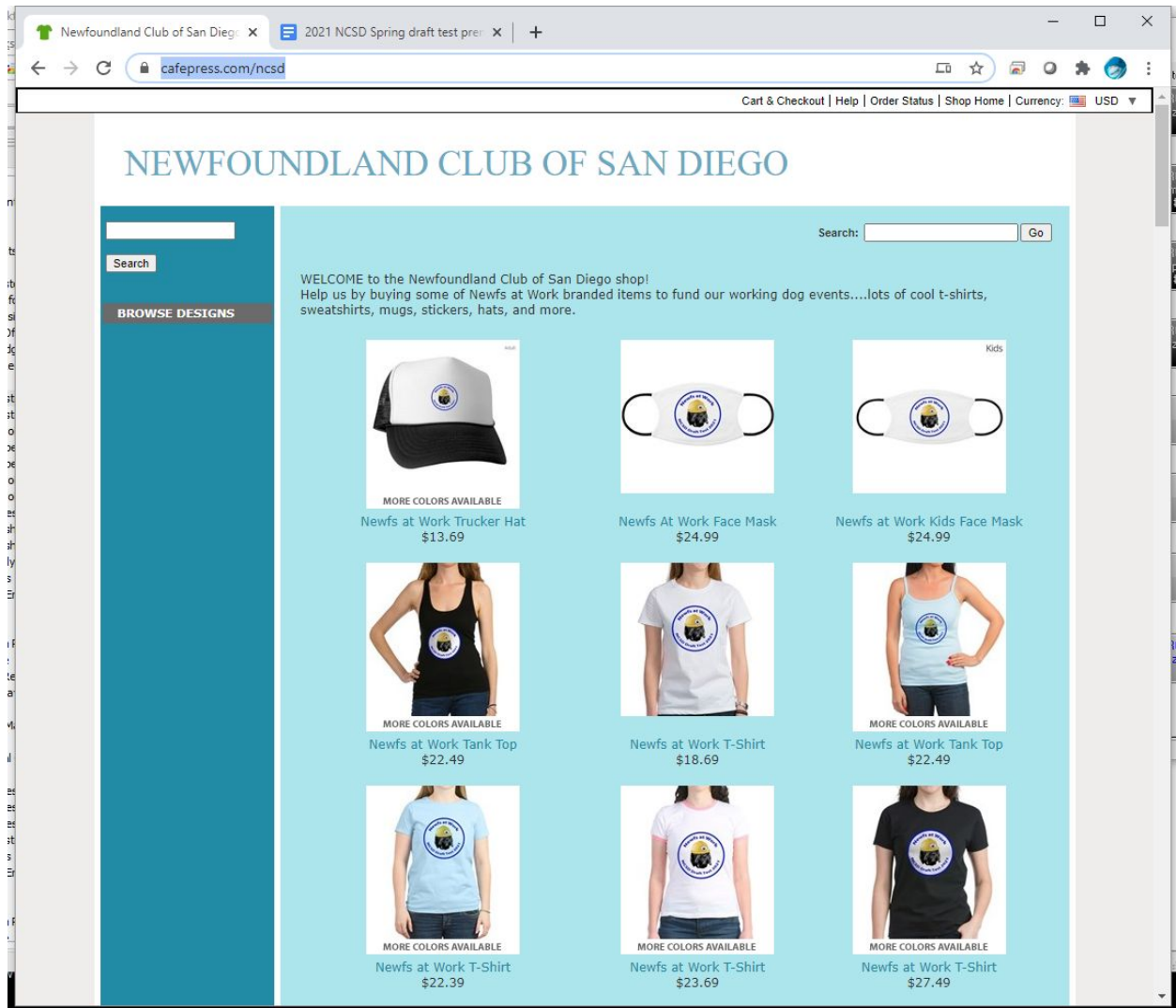

COVID-19 Plan for the NCSD Draft Tests March 13 & 14, 2021

These tests are so fortunate to be taking place in a commercial business park surrounding Sunrise Rentals which provides linens and other housewares to high end serviced apartments and executive housing. Any and all supplies necessary to keep our exhibitors, stewards and committee members safe and protected is already on site. Trudie and Mark Strumwasser, our hosts, are always current on the latest applicable local COVID-19 regulations.

These tests will be conducted in compliance with the regulations of the health departments of the state of California and the county of San Diego in effect on the days the tests are held.

Everyone arriving at the test will have their temperature taken using a distance digital thermometer and must have a temperature of 100 or less. Hand sanitizer will be available.

Everyone will be required to wear a mask at all times except when actually handling a dog.

Upon arrival, text the test secretary that you have arrived. Between 7:20-7:50am, the test secretary will then let you know when it is your turn to check in. Multiple pens will be available and sanitized after each use.

Entrants will handle and stage their own equipment. Entrants may remove their masks when actually working their dog/dogs unless they are less than six feet from someone, for example when the judges are examining the harness and hitch.

Everyone attending the event is requested to bring their own food and drink.

Bathrooms are located inside the facility and will be equipped with appropriate supplies.

Because of the nature of the site there will be few if any people present other than those associated with the tests. We anticipate some spectators. Because this is the NCSD's first working test in many years the club feels it is important to allow spectators but they will be encouraged to set up along the freight haul route with their lawn chairs and coolers, maintaining appropriate social distancing.
