

Single-sort Recycling: Frequently Asked Questions

WHAT DO I DO WITH MY OLD BIN?

You can keep your old bin or drop it off at the Solid Waste Campus office at 1873 Bench Street. All returned bins will be recycled.

WHY ARE RECYCLABLES BEING COLLECTED EVERY OTHER WEEK?

To keep fees low, and because our new carts hold more, recycling will be picked up on a biweekly schedule. Your pick-up day will remain the same.

DO I HAVE TO PUT MY RECYCLABLES IN MY CART?

Yes. Crews will only collect recyclables placed in the cart. Do not place material loose on the ground or in any other container.

SHOULD I BAG MY RECYCLING BEFORE PUTTING IT IN THE CART?

No. Plastic bags are non-recyclable and can't be processed by the machines at the recycling facility. Recyclables can be placed directly into the cart.

CAN I TAKE MY CART WITH ME IF I MOVE?

Carts are registered to an address and are the property of the City of Red Wing. Please leave the cart if you move.

WHAT IF MY CART IS STOLEN OR DAMAGED?
