Accepting Hazardous Waste

Entry Fees for Household Waste Drop-off (Proof of Town of Carbondale residency required)
Must pay all fees at the gate! Check, cash, debit/credit card accepted.

Town of Carbondale (resident)	\$10	Non-resident	\$30
Load with trailer (resident)	\$20	Non-resident	\$60

Mountain Waste: (Entrance located on Colorado Ave. across Town Hall)

- General household trash (furniture/fencing, etc.)
- Metal recycling
- Wood recycling
- Mattress recycling (\$30/mattress paid at the gate)
- Textile recycling (must be in bags for recycling)
- Refrigerator/freezer with freon - \$40 per unit Air conditioning unit - \$50/unit (all paid at the gate)

All customers must pay charges related to refrigerators and other freon items.

VENDOR SERVICES (below):

Free for Town residents only until Town subsidy is met. Out-of-Town residents must pay the fees.

Blue Star Recyclers: E-Waste (Located in the parking lot behind Town Hall)

- ELECTRONIC WASTE (Computers, hard drives, cell phones)
- TV's: Flat screen, CRT display and projector tv's, cords and power supplies
- Cameras, recording and computer equipment, radios, microwave, DVR/DVD/CD players
- MEDIA: CD/DVD/tapes
- LIGHT BULBS: Fluorescent tubes, Incandescent, CFL, U-tubes, Halogen, LED straight tubes, HID and LED bulbs, UV lights

Clean Harbors: Household Hazardous Waste & Batteries (Located in the Thunder River Theater parking lot on 6th St.)

- Motor oil
- Paint (Oil & Latex based), thinner and stains
- Poisons
- Antifreeze
- Pesticides/poisons
- Aerosol cans
- Acids and bases
- Batteries: Alkaline, lead acid, nickel cadmium and small lithium batteries

ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED

- Ammunition/explosives/fireworks
- Radioactive waste including smoke detectors
- Flares & ammunition
- Bio-hazardous waste, infectious waste
- Fire extinguishers

• **Yard waste and branches: (Saturday, May 3 & 17)**

Yard waste and branches 2" or less in diameter will be accepted at the seasonal Yard Waste event that begins on April 20, 2024, and every-other weekend through September. This event is located at 4th & Colorado, 9a-noon. Town residents only.

Crews will alternate lunches between noon and 1p. Unloading may take additional time during this timeframe. Plan accordingly.
