Important Jewish Dates (fast days) This Summer

Sunday, July 21 - Fast of Tammuz

This fast commemorates one of the final steps in the fall of ancient Jerusalem. The fast normally is observed on Tammuz 17. This year, Tammuz 17 will be on Shabbat, July 20; and Yom Kippur is the only fast allowed on Shabbat. When any public fast would fall on a Shabbat, it is postponed to the following Sunday.

Sunday, August 11 - Tisha B'Av (observed)

Tisha B'Av (the ninth day of the month of Av) commemorates the day that the ancient Beit HaMikdash (Temple of Jerusalem) fell. It was torched on Av 9 and continued to burn on Av 10. Like the Fast of Tammuz this year, Tisha B'Av is moved from a Shabbat to a Sunday so as to not mitigate the simcha and menuchah (the joy and relaxation) appropriate for every Shabbat.
